- * calendar routine (customize it to meet your needs - try attendance and lunch count!)
- * Interactive word work (Sitton Spelling, making words, boggle, chunks/sorts, etc.)
- * Quick-and-easy math intervention (aka: small group games!)
- * Hands-"on" Science experiments/investigations (no mess! 😊)
